Good Shepherd School begins each year in mid - September and concludes in mid - June. Families are asked to submit this application with a \$200.00 non-refundable application fee. Filing out an application does not guarantee a space in the Good Shepherd School Preschool Program. After you have submitted your application you will be contacted to schedule an interview and a time for your child to spend some time in one of our classrooms for observation. Acceptance letters will be mailed March 9, 2016. Contracts and a \$1,000 tuition deposit are due March 30, 2016.

Tuition is yearly and is payable in full by June 1, 2016 or through FACTS Tuition Management Service.

If using FACTS, you must sign up by FACTS by June 1, 2016. Through FACTS you will pay the annual tuition in **10 installments** beginning on July 7th of the year that the child enrolls in the Good Shepherd School Program. (For example, the family will pay the first tuition installment for September 2016 enrollment on July 7, 2016. Nine additional installments will follow on the 5th of each month respectively and will be made through FACTS Tuition Management options.
