Supposedly it goes with aging – forgetting where something is – not remembering where you last saw/used or placed an item. While I resist that as an exclusive characteristic of someone over '60, I have to admit some truth to the theorem. Losing one's keys seems the most annoying, perhaps only bested by misplacing a cell phone.

Most of us can identify with the emotion of discovering something is lost – seems like it happens just when we need it ...! And can you recall how you feel when the object is found, especially if the search has gone on for a

bit and others have been helping? The relief is huge.

But there are other kinds of losses we all know about: jobs, homes, friendships, money, health, agility, independence, even freedom that may not be resolved as we may hope. Truth is, life includes many moments when we face loss, and some are devastating. Sometimes our losses, big and small, can nurture a self pity and that can lead to magnify the loss in our lives.

One common response to certain types of loss is, "Why?" We search for answers and we often seek to find out whom or what is to blame for the loss. And often enough the answer is elusive and our anger is directed to God: "Why did God let this happen to ME?" This course may cause us to turn away from the very One who seeks to comfort, sustain and direct us in times of trial.

So how do we live with loss? The movement of life is only in one direction – there is no going back. The pain of loss and change can break us or can open us to a new way of being. Instead of asking "Why", in faith, one can ask "What": "What does God want me to do now? What can I do to move forward? What can I learn from this loss?"

I recall being at a very low point in my life, struggling with change and loss. I wandered into a bookstore and was browsing around. There was a display of


book marks, little plastic strips printed with a quote or saying. One read, "The will of God will never lead you where the Grace of God will not sustain you". I bought that book mark and took great comfort in that truth. I needed to accept the loss and changes and seek to move forward, to learn, to grow, to adapt and to trust.

Marion Howard once wrote: "Life is like a blanket too short. You pull it up and your toes rebel, you yank it down and shivers meander about your shoulder; but cheerful folks manage to draw their knees up and pass a very comfortable night". God gives to each of us whatever we need to live through the losses of our lives. When we believe that, actually trust that truth, then the loss can yield something to be found.

Maybe Charles Schultz is right when he says: "Life is like a ten-speed bicycle. Most of us have gears we never use". Indeed, we need to try out the other gears – they are there to be used and when we do, we may find a speed that really works very well for us.

Friends, the God who made us, who knows us better than we know ourselves and whose love for us is constant and unconditional will never abandon us. As we go forward with the losses and the finds of our life, look around. There is some new insight and experience awaiting, and God is behind us all the way.



Stewardship and Leisure Time



The number of travelers on the highways and in airports is a hopeful sign that those nightmarish months, filled with anxiety and stress, are over. Some business analysts suggest that Americans may have a tendency to want to “catch up” with the work they have not been able to accomplish these past 14- 16 months. Those in the mental health fields argue, however, for extended periods of rest and relaxation, especially now in the summer months. They argue for longer respites from work and even trips that take us away from cell phone coverage, internet and Zoom meetings.

Maybe we are not in a position to take much time off, but all of us can resonate with the need to really “get away” from work or the daily grind or the constant demands of social media. Even the Gospels suggest that good stewardship of our bodies, minds and souls obliges us to get away on a regular basis (see Luke 5:16).

As Christian stewards, we aren’t just encouraged but obligated to consider how we approach our stewardship of leisure time. Stewards are aware of their need to be busy doing God’s work, but often forget that down time is equally important to spiritual growth. Leisure time, whether it’s our evenings, our weekends, or our vacation, provides spiritual, physical, mental and emotional recharging. Leisure is necessary for human wholeness. Leisure reconnects us to the wider mysteries of our world and our God. It helps us daydream, imagine, pray. It refreshes our spirit.

Today, connectivity has become almost an obsession. People check their emails, their messages and calls with alarming repetitiveness. Accidents, both pedestrian and automobile, happen because people can’t put down their phones. Employers expect their workers to be available for evening emails. The lines between work and free time increasingly blur, as do the lines between solitude and always being present “online.” We can’t imagine putting aside screens for a two-week vacation. But we must give ourselves time to renew and recharge, not just two weeks of the year, but each day and each week.

July offers an opportunity to reconnect with the rhythms of God and nature. We need to take time off from screens and phones, and practice giving undivided attention to the things before us. When we pray, we commit time and silence. When we enjoy time with our friends and family, we practice being totally present. When we sit on the patio or at the beach, we give ourselves wholly to the wind or the waves. Be a good steward of your body, mind and soul. Don’t overschedule your time off. Listen to the quiet whisper of God encouraging you to relax.



LA MIRADA DE JESÚS

Marcos describe con todo detalle la situación. Jesús se dirige en barca con sus discípulos hacia un lugar tranquilo y retirado. Quiere escucharles con calma, pues han vuelto cansados de su primera correría evangelizadora y desean compartir su experiencia con el Profeta que los ha enviado. El propósito de Jesús queda frustrado. La gente descubre su intención y se les adelanta corriendo por la orilla. Cuando llegan al lugar, se encuentran con una multitud venida de todas las aldeas del entorno. ¿Cómo reaccionará Jesús?

Marcos describe gráficamente su actuación: los discípulos han de aprender cómo han de tratar a la gente; en las comunidades cristianas se ha de recordar cómo era Jesús con esas personas perdidas en el anonimato, de las que nadie se preocupa. «Al desembarcar, Jesús vio un gran gentío, sintió compasión de ellos, pues eran como ovejas sin pastor, y se puso a enseñarles muchas cosas». Lo primero que destaca el evangelista es la mirada de Jesús. No se irrita porque hayan interrumpido sus planes. Los mira detenidamente y se conmueve. Nunca le molesta la gente. Su corazón intuye la desorientación y el abandono en que se encuentran los campesinos de aquellas aldeas.

En la Iglesia hemos de aprender a mirar a la gente como la miraba Jesús: captando el sufrimiento, la soledad, el desconcierto o el abandono que sufren muchos. La compasión no brota de la atención a las normas o el recuerdo de nuestras obligaciones. Se despierta en nosotros cuando miramos atentamente a los que sufren.

Desde esa mirada Jesús descubre la necesidad más profunda de aquellas gentes: «andan como ovejas sin pastor». La enseñanza que reciben de los letrados de la Ley no les ofrece el alimento que necesitan. Viven sin que nadie cuide realmente de ellas. No tienen un pastor que las guíe y las defienda.

Movido por su compasión, Jesús «se pone a enseñarles muchas cosas». Con calma, sin prisas, se dedica pacientemente a enseñarles la Buena Noticia de Dios. No lo hace por obligación. No piensa en sí mismo. Les comunica la Palabra de Dios, conmovido por la necesidad que tienen de un pastor. No podemos permanecer indiferentes ante tanta gente que, dentro de nuestras comunidades cristianas, anda buscando un alimento más sólido que el que recibe. No hemos de aceptar como normal la desorientación religiosa dentro de la Iglesia. Hemos de reaccionar de manera lúcida y responsable. No pocos cristianos buscan ser mej
