I think most all of us were looking forward to September bringing in a new era of hope and returning to a style of living around the city free from the challenges and hard restrictions imposed by the pandemic. And now as we need to start wearing masks again and the news from near and far is so grim, everyone has to dig

deep to find a positive energy. On the one hand, one could look around and see people who are suffering in unimaginable ways, for example, in Haiti and in Afghanistan. On the other hand, every person and family searches to find his or her footing given our current reality.

Recently, I was writing to families of school-age children regarding our religious education program. Conscious of how very stressed parents are as the opening of school fast approaches, the last thing I wanted to do was to increase anxiety with a list of to do's. As I think about these times, it seems to me that preparing ourselves and our children to grow more deeply in their faith is really not a task on a checklist, it is more a gift and a rich, valuable resource.

Standing with people who have undergone profound losses and setbacks throughout my many years as a priest has often offered me moments of inspiration, even edification. For it is when we find ourselves in some of our deepest holes or facing the steepest of mountains and feeling helpless that our faith can often lead us forward. It is, in fact, a tapping into the faith knowledge of the infinite power of God manifest in God's unconditional love for each of us.

For the person of Jesus Christ is meant to be that ineffable resource and strength for anyone who so chooses to accept such a friendship. I fully realize this perspective does not make sense and is not an empirically verifiable way of living. Nonetheless, it is a truth.

The story of Jesus Christ has been known for more than 2000 years and prophesized long before. Christ represents an entire absolute truth that is not a relative or subjective one, rather absolute. This truth is not a history story, although it cer-

LA QUEJA DE DIOS

Un grupo de fariseos de Galilea se acerca a Jesús en actitud crítica. No vienen solos. Les acompañan algunos escribas venidos de Jerusalén, preocupados sin duda por defender la ortodoxia de los sencillos campesinos de las aldeas. La actuación de Jesús es peligrosa. Conviene corregirla.


Han observado que, en algunos aspectos, sus discípulos no siguen la tradición de los mayores. Aunque hablan del comportamiento de los discípulos, su pregunta se dirige a Jesús, pues saben que es él quien

les ha enseñado a vivir con aquella libertad sorprendente. ¿Por qué? Jesús les responde con unas palabras del profeta Isaías que iluminan muy bien su mensaje y su actuación. Estas palabras con las que Jesús se identifica totalmente hemos de escucharlas con atención, pues tocan algo muy fundamental de nuestra religión. Según el profeta, esta es la queja Dios.

"Este pueblo me honra con los labios, pero su corazón está lejos de mí". Este es siempre el riesgo de toda religión: dar culto a Dios con los labios, repitiendo fórmulas, recitando salmos, pronunciando palabras hermosas, mientras nuestro corazón "está lejos de él". Sin embargo, el culto que agrada a Dios nace del corazón, de la adhesión interior, de ese centro íntimo de la persona de donde nacen nuestras decisiones y proyectos. Cuando nuestro corazón está lejos de Dios, nuestro culto queda sin contenido. Le falta la vida, la escucha sincera de la Palabra de Dios, el amor al hermano. La religión se convierte en algo exterior que se practica por costumbre, pero en la que faltan los frutos de una vida fiel a Dios.

La doctrina que enseñan son preceptos humanos. En toda religión hay tradiciones que son "humanas". Normas, costumbres, devociones que han nacido para vivir la religiosidad en una determinada cultura. Pueden hacer mucho bien. Pero hacen mucho daño cuando nos distraen y alejan de lo que Dios espera de nosotros. Nunca han de tener la primacía.

Al terminar la cita del profeta Isaías, Jesús resume su pensamiento con unas palabras muy graves: "Vosotros dejáis de lado el mandamiento de Dios para aferraros a la tradición de los hombres". Cuando nos aferramos ciegamente a tradiciones humanas, corremos el riesgo de olvidar el mandato del amor y desviarnos del seguimiento a Jesús, Palabra encarnada de Dios. En la religión cristiana, lo primero es siempre Jesús y su llamada al amor. Solo después vienen nuestras tradiciones humanas, por muy importantes que nos puedan parecer. No hemos de olvidar nunca lo esencial.
