## LISTENING ...

Then you will call on me  
and come and pray to  
me, and I will listen to  
you. - Jeremiah 29:12

In the course of any parish priest's day, there are many varied activities. Really, from concern over some item of the buildings to time spent with a family grieving the death of a loved one, the spectrum is broad and deep – and I love it! Often the activity that is the most important and precious is listening. We priests are good

listeners – at least we try to be! Now that might not sound like “heavy lifting” – yet there are many times when it is! It depends on the matter being discussed. If it is about the future of a cherished quarterback for the New England Patriots, that is one thing; if the subject is a family coping with a loved one diagnosed with a terminal cancer, that is something else.

Listening, in any event, calls one to offer complete attention to the other – and often we do not listen that way! As we hear another speaking, we are inclined to anticipate what the individual will say and then formulate our response before the person has finished speaking! At other times, one's mind is elsewhere while another is speaking. Many of us have done this and have been in conversations where this is common, and when we reflect on it we come to realize that this is not true listening.

Some years ago, Carl Rogers, a noted psychologist and prolific author, introduced a new way of looking at effective therapy. Among other things, he suggested that what he called; “*Unconditional Positive Regard*” was crucial to effective psychotherapy. Rogers was talking about how we listen. He taught that healing can take place when, in an encounter, a listener gives his/her entire attention to the other in a positive and nonjudgmental way, allowing the person to speak and accepting without judgment whatever is said. A person's hurts, brokenness, shame, anxiety, fear, inferiority, confused identity, and so much more can improve. On the one hand, it sounds so elementary and yet, in truth, it is so profound.

This very experience happens all the time, among friends, spouses, colleagues, and teachers .... It is that phenomenon of one human being caring for another; caring in such a way as to make it possible for another to experience and grow in love and, at times, to help another to open up and unburden all kinds of trouble and pain that is within. We all need such opportunities, and everyone is healthier because of them. At the same time, we all know there are some parts of life, some experiences, choices, and actions that are very difficult and cannot easily be spoken about. Sometimes a priest can help.

Actually, it is better to say, all the time, God can help. And God has chosen, for God's own reasons, to be present to us in countless ways. A very specific and deeply helpful way in which God is present is through the Sacraments of the Church. The Sacrament of Reconciliation often referred to as "Confession", is one of these Sacraments. The fact that few use the Sacrament in these days does not diminish its value and its availability to be a source of Grace and healing for those who approach this precious gift.

Since my Ordination as a Priest in June 1982 to this present day, I am in awe of how God uses this sacrament to bring His love to people in these moments. Further, while I am well aware of the effectiveness of counseling and therapy – the listening that happens in this Sacrament occasions a time of Grace: God is present and the Priest serves only as an instrument of this Grace in ways that are far beyond understanding.

A priest is available every Saturday afternoon from 3:15 – 3:45 in the Confession corner in the upper Church. In addition, any person can contact the Parish Office to set up an appointment to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Rogers is right – lovingly listening to another can be a wonderful and healing experience. Imagine how much more such a moment can be when one seeks God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the fruits of that are forgiveness, healing, and consolation.

## TOMAR EN SERIO A JESÚS

El episodio de Cesarea de Filipo ocupa un lugar central en el evangelio de Marcos. Después de un tiempo de convivir con él, Jesús hace a sus discípulos una pregunta decisiva: "¿Quién decís que soy yo?". En nombre de todos, Pedro le contesta sin dudar: "Tú eres el Mesías". Por fin parece que todo está claro. Jesús es el Mesías enviado por Dios, y los discípulos lo siguen para colaborar con él.

Pero Jesús sabe que no es así. Todavía les falta aprender algo muy importante. Es fácil confesar a Jesús con palabras, pero todavía no saben lo que significa seguirlo de cerca compartiendo su proyecto y su destino. Marcos dice que Jesús "empezó a enseñarles" que debía sufrir mucho. No es una enseñanza más, sino algo fundamental que los discípulos tendrán que ir asimilando poco a poco.

Desde el principio les habla "con toda claridad". No les quiere ocultar nada. Tienen que saber que el sufrimiento lo acompañará siempre en su tarea de abrir caminos al reino de Dios. Al final, será condenado por los dirigentes religiosos y morirá ejecutado violentamente. Sólo al resucitar se verá que Dios está con él.

Pedro se rebela ante lo que está oyendo. Su reacción es increíble. Toma a Jesús consigo y se lo lleva aparte para "increparlo". Había sido el primero en confesarlo como Mesías. Ahora es el primero en rechazarlo. Quiere hacer ver a Jesús que lo que está diciendo es absurdo. No está dispuesto a que siga ese camino. Jesús ha de cambiar esa manera de pensar.

Jesús reacciona con una dureza desconocida. De pronto ve en Pedro los rasgos de Satanás, el tentador del desierto que busca apartar a las personas de la voluntad de Dios. Se vuelve de cara a los discípulos y "reprende" literalmente a Pedro con estas palabras: "Ponte detrás de mí, Satanás": vuelve a ocupar tu puesto de discípulo. Deja de tentarme. "Tus pensamientos no son los de Dios, sino los de los hombres, ".

Luego llama a la gente y a sus discípulos para que escuchen bien sus palabras. Las repetirá en diversas ocasiones. No las han de olvidar jamás. "Si alguno quiere venir detrás de mí, que renuncie a sí mismo, que cargue con su cruz y que me siga".

Seguir a Jesús no es obligatorio. Es una decisión libre de cada uno. Pero hemos de tomar en serio a Jesús. No bastan confesiones fáciles. Si queremos seguirlo en su tarea apasionante de hacer un mundo más humano, digno y dichoso, hemos de estar dispuestos a dos cosas. Primero, renunciar a proyectos o planes que se oponen al reino de Dios. Segundo, aceptar los sufrimientos que nos pueden llegar por seguir a Jesús e identificarnos con su causa.

### September Observances

**National Hispanic Heritage Month** is observed in the U.S. from September 15 through October 15.
