# The Parish Pastoral Council 2022

On Palm Sunday, April 10, 2022 at the 10:30 a.m. Family Mass, we will select names of persons who have been nominated and have accepted nomination to be members of our Parish Pastoral Council. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, four (4) names will be selected by lot. The nomination process begins on the weekend of March 19/20. Only registered parishioners may nominate or be nominated.

Nominees must also participate in the sacramental life of the Church and be 18 years of age or older. PPC members must serve a full term of three (3) years and attend monthly meetings from September to June. As a consultative body, the Parish Pastoral Council is responsible to the pastor, assisting and supporting him in his leadership role. It recognizes the varied gifts of the parish members and invites them to an active leadership role in the parish.

The Council is an important means by which the pastor hears the voice of parishioners. In deliberations and consultation with the pastor, the council helps to unite the pastor and parishioners. Together they discern the pastoral needs of the parish and ways in which those needs can be addressed.

Once the nominations are in, the nominees will be contacted to see if they accept the nomination. If they do, their names will go into a "pot" for selection on Palm Sunday. Regardless of how many times people are nominated, their names are placed into the pot only once.

Please prayerfully consider possible candidates for the Council and submit their names no later than Tuesday, April 4, to give us adequate time to contact the nominees prior to selection on Palm Sunday.

## TERCER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

La palabra de Dios en este tercer domingo de este camino que nos conduce a la pascua de resurrección no sitúa en clave de liberación interior, en clave de conversión de lo aquellas cosas que sabemos que no están de acuerdo con lo que Jesús nos pide a cada uno de nosotros.

El texto de la vocación de Moisés de la primera lectura, es el punto de arranque hacia el camino del éxodo que el pueblo de Dios está a punto de iniciar. Dios habla con Moisés y le hace saber sus planes. Dios ha visto la opresión de su pueblo en Egipto, ha oído sus quejas, se ha fijado en sus sufrimientos, y se va a mostrar sensible a su dolor. Como hizo el domingo pasado con Abraham, va a tomar la iniciativa y va a sacarlos de esta situación. Dios opta claramente por los oprimidos, por las víctimas, y se va a hacer presente, cercano a ellas, de la misma manera se hará presente en nuestras vidas y si lo dejamos actuar nos cambiará por dentro.

El evangelio de San Lucas es una invitación explícita a la conversión. La conversión como llamada del tiempo cuaresmal y como llamada permanente para quienes tenemos que asumir nuestra condición humana imperfecta y deseamos avanzar en la búsqueda de la voluntad de Dios en nuestras vidas. La decisión de emprender el camino de la conversión, no puede ir dilatándose sin fecha de término, sino que nos exige una opción firme y clara, decidida y valiente por nuestra parte. Aprovechando la ocasión, Jesús nos pone el ejemplo de la higuera. Es una parábola de una profundidad impresionante. Contiene un mensaje muy rico desde el punto de vista religioso y teológico, demostrándonos como es el comportamiento de Dios, pero con ella Jesús demuestra también un conocimiento de la psicología humana impropio de su tiempo. La ciencia psicológica moderna, tiene como uno de sus principios básicos y fundamentales, que todo proceso de crecimiento siempre puede ser optimizado, no puede darse nunca uno por vencido a la hora de ver los frutos. Y este es sin duda uno de los mensajes de esta parábola.

Pero lo que realmente quiere enseñarnos Jesús con este ejemplo es como es el Dios que él nos quiere transmitir, y esto es muy importante, el rostro del Dios que Jesús están empezando a transmitir es un rostro misericordioso y siempre, siempre dispuesto a olvidar la ofensa reconocida. Si no hay frutos, lo lógico es arrancar y probar con otra cosa, porque la conversión se tiene que realizar en cosas concretas no sólo en buenas intenciones, pero el viñador intercede por ella, y consigue un nuevo plazo a su favor, no está todo perdido, la cuidará, la podará y seguro que dará buenos frutos. Así es Dios, siempre esperando nuestras buenas obras. La bondad, la compasión, la misericordia, la espera confiada son atributos divinos que en Jesús se hacen realidad de una forma especial. No olvidemos esto, porque la liturgia nos está preparando el camino y el domingo próximo, por si hoy no nos ha quedado claro, Jesús nos lo va a decir de una manera que no admite dudas. Dios es paciente con nosotros, pero jamás debemos tomar esa paciencia como excusa para ir posponiendo nuestra conversión, Dios quiere que caminemos hacia esa conversión ya desde hoy y que no lo dejemos para mañana.

No cabe duda, que cada uno debemos pensar que esa higuera somos nosotros, cada uno es esa higuera estéril, las veces que en mi vida no doy los frutos que debo dar, las veces que he cerrado los oídos para no oír lo que Dios me pide, las veces que sabiendo lo que tengo que cambiar no hago nada por lograrlo, ¿cuántas veces Dios ha tenido paciencia conmigo y sigue esperando mi conversión? Esta lectura nos invita a reflexionar interiormente sobre nuestra realidad de personas que se sienten acogidas y perdonadas por un Padre que quiere siempre lo mejor para nosotros. Y esta realidad es la que nos anima cada domingo a intentar ser un poco mejores sin desanimarnos ni venimos abajo por nuestros fracasos. Se lo pedimos al Señor especialmente para cada uno de nosotros, que la meditación asidua de estas reflexiones nos haga ir interiorizando su realidad, y recordamos también a todos los que sufren, están solos o enfermos.

### Prayers Before Mass

Try to get to Mass early so you can pray before Mass.

You've heard the conventional wisdom, "You get out of it what you put into it." And that surely applies to the Mass. Here's an adapted excerpt from a prayer by St. Thomas Aquinas you may consider praying:

"May I receive the Bread of Angels, the King of Kings, and Lord of Lords, with the reverence and humility, the contrition and devotion, the purity and faith, and the resolve and determination He deserves." Amen.

Remember: you get out of it what you put into it.
