What an honor it is for me to return to the neighborhood of Charlestown and to serve for a month at St. Francis and St. Mary-St. Catherine of Siena Parishes. For those residents who have lived in this community for awhile, you may remember me as the “young priest” who was at St. Catherine’s from 1990 – 1996. They were six wonderful years in my life and in the Catholic Church in Charlestown. I had the privilege of serving in this community alongside the legendary Fr. Dan Mahoney at St. Francis. At that time Fr. Jim Canniff was at St. Mary. The three parishes were all vibrant and thriving in those

years. The Catholic faith has a long history in this neighborhood and you have been served by wonderful priests and faith filled women religious who taught at all three parish schools. I grew up in Roslindale and West Roxbury (Holy Name Parish) and was very involved in my parish as a child and teenager. I know how vital those early years are to families and to the Church. The pandemic has had and will have a lasting effect on if and how many people celebrate their faith. I respect people’s choices on whether they return to Church or not. But every pastor will tell you how much we miss those families who are no longer physically with us.

I am on the Emergency Response Team (ERT) for the Archdiocese of Boston. After serving five years as the pastor of three parishes in Hyde Park (Most Precious Blood, St. Pius X and St. Anne) I decided in 2019 to volunteer for the ERT. I now am available to fill in temporarily in various parishes for weeks or months whenever necessary. Most priests live alone so if that priest (usually the pastor) gets sick, goes on a sabbatical, dies suddenly or retires, I am available to replace them until the Archdiocese finds a successor – e.g. – since I left Hyde Park, I have served in Marblehead, Millis, Medway, Hudson and most recently for 6 months in Wilmington. I have met many wonderful people and it has brought me to

## CELEBRATING FR. RONAN

This past Pentecost Sunday, June 5, at the 10:30 Mass, Fr. Ronan celebrated his final Mass as Pastor. What an incredibly magnificent celebration and tribute to the one who, with God's grace, has served our Parish so well for the past 18 years and has ministered faithfully to the people of God as an ordained priest for 40 years! The cheerful, beautifully sunny, warm day mirrored the experience of the over 500 persons in attendance - parishioners, former parishioners, and family and friends of Fr. Ronan.

The outstanding music and singing framed all that took place - from the inspirational scripture readings; to Fr. Ronan's rousing homily; to the hallowed reception of the Eucharist, the source and summit of our lives; to the glowing tributes to Fr. Ronan given by parishioners, Jim Coviello and Sally Walker; Joe Reardon, Board member of Rostro de Cristo ([rostrodecristo.org](http://rostrodecristo.org)); and Jennifer Poulos, Chair of the Good Shepherd School ([gsscharlestown.org](http://gsscharlestown.org)).

As you may know, both the organization Rostro de Cristo (Face of Christ) and the Good Shepherd School were founded by Fr. Ronan.

Following the Mass, a festive reception was held in the Parish Center parking lot, where Fr. Ronan was given symbolic gifts: a framed digitally painted picture of the outside and inside of St. Mary Church; a Book of Remembrance with pictures from various moments in the last 40 years of Fr. Ronan's life; and a wooden cross with the inscription:

This cross is presented to Fr. James J. Ronan in loving gratitude for his 18 years of dedicated leadership and ministry in our Parish and for 40 years of priestly ordination. It was created from materials of St. Mary's Church pews and was fashioned by Oscar Calderón. Ad multos annos!

In summary, those who attended, including Fr. Ronan, came away feeling what the refrain of the opening hymn proclaimed, "The God of all grace has blessed us this day, all of creation joins us in praise; lifting our voices, lifting our hearts to the glory of God forever!"
