*Friends,*

I'm a believer that whatever takes place in the world forces each of us to re-evaluate our faith and our value system. We live at a time when issues have become so volatile: social issues, political issues, moral issues. This can be very frightening to so many and their response is to revert back to "the good old days" and imagine that if we just could live again as we did then, life would once again be stable and predictable.

I understand that yearning and nostalgia for the past. The Church in a sense is caught in the middle because the citizens of our Church are also citizens of our world. The issues they face are the issues we must face. The result is that religion itself can become so controversial. For example, the Catholic Church as an institution is asked to make statements and proclamations about legal, sexual and life-altering procedures.

In some cases the ballot questions during an election year force us to look at the proposed changes and cast our vote. In these cases, we may decide to cast our vote in line with Catholic Church teaching and believe every Catholic should feel the same way. However, we then speak with family or friends who are also Catholic who disagree and vote differently. It can even be more complicated when we read that the bishops of our Church may even look at many of these issues with various perspectives. Some may be very comfortable dictating that Catholics must adhere to Catholic teaching in all these areas, while other bishops are very comfortable in acquainting us with Church teaching but also respect our right to form our own conscience as we listen, read and face these challenging issues.

Then there's also life at the parish level. Just as in a diocese the bishops can set the tone, so it is at the local parish where the pastor decides the priorities. Some pastors are more collaborative than others which means they would do more consulting and enter into dialogue with parish leaders and those in ministry positions before decisions are made. The dividing line between politics and religion has gotten much thinner, which is why the Catholic Church has a much more difficult challenge in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

Here are some of the issues that Catholics will expect their Church to face in today's world. We may be in agreement with our Church or disappointed with our Church. Some may choose to leave their local parish or even leave the Church over the Church's public stand on the following: immigration, gender



## Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time - November 12/13, 2022

**'Fear not, for I am with you;  
'Be not dismayed, for I am  
your God.  
I will strengthen you,

Isaiah 41:10

In today's Gospel Jesus suggests that his disciples must be prepared to suffer ridicule, persecution and perhaps even death if they are to follow him. Sometimes we may wonder if enduring ridicule and scorn are what we really signed up for when we received the sacraments of initiation. Would we not rather sneak through life as painlessly as possible? Good stewards take their faith seriously and find comfort in the closing words of today's Gospel: "You will be hated by all because of my name but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives." Let us make it part of our daily prayer routine to ask the Holy Spirit for the courage to act in Jesus' name no matter the consequences.

DOMINGO  
del Tiempo Ordinario

Son muchos los textos de los evangelios que son magníficos y fáciles de entender y atractivos para los predicadores, los pasajes que hablan de cosas concretas, que cuentan historias de todos los días: una oveja que se pierde, un hijo que se va de casa, un banquete de bodas, una higuera que no da frutos, un sembrador que sale a sembrar... El evangelio de este domingo, para ustedes y para mí, es una pesadilla, nos describe una realidad que se nos antoja lejana e inverosímil y sin embargo hoy estamos un día más cerca que ayer del Gran Final.

Cuando leemos una novela que nos intriga y atrapa, todos solemos hacer una trampa. No podemos esperar a averiguar el desenlace y nos vamos a la última página para saber cómo termina la historia. Nos interesa más el Final de la trama que el resto de las aventuras de los personajes.

Los doce apóstoles, llegados a Jerusalén desde Galilea, contemplan como turistas embelesados el segundo Templo. "El papel de Templo en la vida judía era de suma importancia. El Templo sirve de calendario y de reloj para los Judíos; sus ritos marcan el ciclo del año y dan forma a las actividades del día a día de cada habitante de Jerusalén. Es el centro del comercio para toda Judea, es su institución financiera principal y el mayor banco. Tel Templo es la casa del Dios de Israel y la sede de las aspiraciones nacionalistas de Israel. Guarda los rollos de los escritos sagrados y todos los documentos legales e históricos y todos los documentos genealógicos de la nación judía".

El primer Templo, el de Salomón, fue destruido por Nabucodonosor el año 586 A.C. Y mientras admiran la belleza del segundo Templo, embellecido y magnificado por Herodes, Jesús les dice a esos doce turistas: "Esto que contempláis, llegará un día en que no quedará piedra sobre piedra, todo será destruido". En el año 70 de nuestra era, la profecía de Jesús se cumplió al pie de la letra. Ahora sólo queda el Muro de las Lamentaciones para que los nuevos turistas depositen en las grieta de las piedras sus oraciones imposibles. El Templo-estado desapareció. El sacerdocio desapareció. Los sacrificios desaparecieron. El culto en el lugar elegido por Yahvé, Jerusalén, desapareció. El judaísmo desapareció. ¿Se imaginan ustedes que un terremoto, un atentado o un incendio redujeran a cenizas el Vaticano o la basílica del Pilar? Seguro que a Dios le gusta el Vaticano y la Basílica del Pilar y las grandiosas catedrales que los hombres han construido, otra cosa muy distinta es que Dios esté a gusto en ellas.

Todo lo humano y todos los humanos estamos destinados a morir. Las palabras del evangelio de este domingo, a pesar de la lejanía en el tiempo, parecen copiadas de los periódicos de hoy. Jesús presenta a los turistas que lo acompañan en Jerusalén el telediario, el noticiero del día. "Habrà terremotos, epidemias, hambre, espantos y grandes signos en el cielo". Las piedras materiales no valen nada. El verdadero Templo se edifica con las piedras espirituales, con personas que adoran a Dios en espíritu y en verdad. Todo tiene un final y hasta el mundo en el que vivimos tendrá su Gran Final. Si preguntan a Google por el Fin del Mundo les dirá que son muchos los falsos profetas que lo han anunciado en 242 fechas distintas y ninguna ha resultado ser cierta.

La verdad es que podemos olvidarnos del Gran Final. Cada uno de nosotros vivimos grandes finales a lo largo de nuestra vida. El cantante se pregunta: ¿Por qué mi corazón sigue latiendo? ¿Por qué lloran esos ojos míos? ¿No saben que es el fin del mundo? Se acabó cuando dijiste adiós. Se acabó cuando perdí tu amor. The Carpenters. El Fin del Mundo se nos echa encima cuando muere un esposo, cuando me despiden del trabajo, cuando fracasa un matrimonio, cuando me diagnostican una enfermedad sin remedio, cuando... Los Finales que nos entregan filmados nos angustian poco, afectan a otros. Los pequeños, los que me afectan a mí, esos son los que nos devuelven a la realidad, no todo tiene un fin próximo, yo sí.

La Fe me pone a prueba y sólo en el silencio de la oración ante Dios puedo asumir en paz mi Gran Final. No tengo que ser como los niños que a lo largo del viaje preguntan cien veces ¿cuándo llegamos? La hora de la llegada pertenece a Dios Padre. La respuesta de Jesús es: perseverad, no os dejéis engañar, que el miedo no controle vuestra vida. Si no encontramos a Dios en medio de nuestras complicadas circunstancias no lo encontraremos en ninguna parte. Todos los templos serán destruidos, sólo permanecerá el templo espiritual que estamos llamados a edificar y habitar.
