We know Christ is present when we are gathered for Eucharist. It is easy to believe Christ is present when we are comfortable with loved ones and friends. But are we as aware of Christ's presence when we are with people who look different from us or hold opposing views to ours? Do we believe that Christ is just as present and makes a difference in those situations? SEVEN SORROWS (DOLORS) OF MARY

Devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows became a standard devotion in the Church around the 14th century. It was revealed to St. Bridget of Sweden (1303-1373) that devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary's Seven Sorrows would bring great signal graces. The devotion consists in praying seven Hail Mary's while meditating on the Seven Sorrows of Mary. Mary, in a unique way, willingly suffered alongside her Divine Son as he gave his life to save the world, and she felt the bitterness of his passion as only a mother can. This devotion is especially remembered during September, the Month of Our Lady of Sorrows (the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15th), and during the season of Lent.

La tribu Babemba de Sudáfrica celebra el siguiente ritual para corregir la conducta criminal o antisocial de sus miembros. Si un miembro de la comunidad actúa irresponsablemente se le coloca en la plaza del pueblo. El trabajo cesa, y todos los hombres, mujeres y niños forman un gran círculo alrededor del acusado. Y uno a uno, incluidos los niños van diciendo las virtudes y todas las cosas buenas que el acusado ha realizado.

No se puede ni mentir ni exagerar ni inventarse nada. No se puede decir ninguna cosa negativa del acusado. La ceremonia dura un par de días hasta que todos han tenido la oportunidad de contar sus bondades. Al final el círculo se rompe, la fiesta comienza y la persona es acogida de nuevo en la comunidad. El acusado se siente fortalecido y animado a vivir de acuerdo con las normas e ideales de la comunidad.

El mal existe, las conductas antisociales existen, el pecado existe a mi alrededor y dentro de mí. Y el pecado existe en la comunidad de Jesús. Somos una comunidad de pecadores. En este evangelio de Mato, Jesús nos dice cómo hay que resolver las situaciones conflictivas, cómo hay que tratar al pecador, a los hermanos de la iglesia. Primero. Habla en privado con la persona que te ha ofendido. Cara a cara, en diálogo fraternal o en diálogo acalorado, no importa. Él es el destinatario de tu reproche, tu enojo, tu ira y también de tu responsabilidad y de tu amor. Como Jesús, nosotros tenemos que ofrecer el perdón y el amor a los hermanos de la comunidad. Y como Jesús el ofendido, no el ofensor, es el que da el primer paso, el que busca... ¿Verdad que nosotros lo primero que hacemos es contárselo a otro? Se trata de ganar a un hermano, de afianzarlo en el camino del Señor y de que viva en la comunidad de Jesús. Es el misterio del perdón.

Segundo. Si no te escucha lleva contigo dos o tres testigos. "Porque donde dos o tres están reunidos en mi nombre, ahí estoy yo". Donde está Jesús está la salvación y el perdón. Donde está Jesús hay que doblar no sólo la rodilla, hay que doblar y ablandar el corazón, rendirse a Él y perdonar como Él. El ofendido, no el ofensor, y los hermanos dan el primer paso, buscan al ofensor para ganar a un hermano y que éste permanezca en la iglesia de Jesús. Tercero. Si no hace caso, díselo a la comunidad. A la comunidad, la iglesia reunida, para escuchar el mensaje de su Señor y para perdonar. La iglesia es lugar de escucha y de perdón. La iglesia es responsable de la vida cristiana de todos sus miembros. Su misión es la de reconciliar a todos con Dios y a los hermanos con los hermanos.

Que ninguno se pierda. Que ninguno almacene el veneno del odio. Que ninguno se obstine en el pecado. Que ninguno destruya la comunidad de Jesús. Que ninguno viva lejos del amor de Dios. Confesar, admitir el pecado es vencer su poder mortal. La comunidad reunida celebra el regalo del perdón de Dios. Todos unidos bajo la mirada de Dios nos dejamos perdonar y nos abrimos al don de la reconciliación con los hermanos. "Perdónanos, Padre, nuestras ofensas como también nosotros..." Cuarto. Al que rechaza la conversión y el perdón de Dios Padre y de los hermanos considéralo como gentil o publicano. Quinto. Puertas siempre abiertas. "Tal vez sea menos pecado matar a alguien que negarle el perdón. Matar a alguien puede ser efecto de la pasión. No perdonar es una elección del corazón. Es un crimen espiritual que excluye y mata la imagen de la persona odiada
