NUEVA ETAPA EVANGELIZA-DORA

El papa Francisco nos está llamando a una «nueva etapa evangelizadora marcada por la alegría de Jesús». ¿En qué puede consistir? ¿Dónde puede estar su novedad? ¿Qué hemos de cambiar? ¿Cuál fue realmente la intención de Jesús al enviar a sus discípulos a prolongar su tarea evangelizadora?

El relato de Marcos deja claro que solo Jesús es la fuente, el inspirador y el modelo de la acción evangelizadora de sus seguidores. No harán nada en nombre propio. Son «enviados» de Jesús. No se predicarán a sí mismos: solo anunciarán su Evangelio. No tendrán otros intereses: solo se dedicarán a abrir caminos al reino de Dios.

La única manera de impulsar una «nueva etapa evangelizadora marcada por la alegría de Jesús» es purificar e intensificar esta vinculación con Jesús. No habrá nueva evangelización si no hay nuevos evangelizadores, y no habrá nuevos evangelizadores si no hay un contacto más vivo, lúcido y apasionado con Jesús. Sin él haremos todo menos introducir su Espíritu en el mundo. Al enviarlos, Jesús no deja a sus discípulos abandonados a sus fuerzas. Les da su «poder», que no es un poder para controlar, gobernar o dominar a los demás, sino su fuerza para «expulsar espíritus inmundos», liberando a las personas de lo que las esclaviza, oprime y deshumaniza.

Los discípulos saben muy bien qué les encarga Jesús. Nunca lo han visto gobernando a nadie. Siempre lo han conocido curando heridas, aliviando el sufrimiento, regenerando vidas, liberando de miedos, contagiando confianza en Dios. «Curar» y «liberar» son tareas prioritarias en la actuación de Jesús. Darían un rostro radicalmente diferente a nuestra evangelización. Jesús los envía con lo necesario para caminar. Según Marcos, solo llevarán bastón, sandalias y una túnica. No necesitan de más para ser testigos de lo esencial. Jesús los quiere ver libres y sin ataduras; siempre disponibles, sin instalarse en el bienestar; confiando en la fuerza del Evangelio.

Sin recuperar este estilo evangélico, no hay «nueva etapa evangelizadora». Lo importante no es poner en marcha nuevas actividades y estrategias, sino desprendernos de costumbres, estructuras y servidumbres que nos están impidiendo ser libres para contagiar lo esencial del Evangelio con verdad y sencillez. En la Iglesia ha perdido ese estilo itinerante que sugiere Jesús. Su caminar es lento y pesado. No sabemos acompañar a la humanidad. No tenemos agilidad para pasar de una cultura ya pasada a otra actual. Nos agarramos al poder que hemos tenido. Nos enredamos en intereses que no coinciden con el reino de Dios. Necesitamos conversión.

July 14 ~ Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The message in our readings again this week remind us that we have been blessed with every spiritual blessing. That is, we have what we need to follow Christ and to give witness to him. In our gospel, we hear Jesus sending his disciples off to preach the good news. They aren't to carry "stuff" that will distract them or stand in the way of being among the people to whom they are sent and to what they were sent to do. We are being invited to accept that we have been chosen in Christ and that we already have the blessings needed to bear witness to his love. They took Jesus' words to heart and trusted him. The question is – will we also trust that truth and act on it?

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL JULY 16TH

Mount Carmel, which juts out into the Mediterranean near Haifa, Israel, has been considered a sacred place since the prophet Elijah built an altar there in his contest with the prophets of Baal. The Carmel headland is traditionally associated with the beginnings of the Carmelite order around 1195, when a group of lay hermits formed a community there. Mary had been honored there as early as the fifth century, and by the 12th century Mount Carmel had become a site of Marian devotion. The Carmelites chose Mary as their protectress and dedicated their oratory on Mount Carmel to her. Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the patron of Bolivia and Chile. This Marian feast became an optional memorial in the Revised Roman Calendar of 1969.





PUT DOWN THE DEVICES

Summer Reset

Binders, gym shoes and lined paper are common school items, but in the past year, for many, those essentials were replaced with iPads, laptops, Zoom and Google Classroom. Technology is a fabulous part of education but was never intended to be the hallmark of instruction. Then along came a pandemic, and that philosophy took a giant shift. Without technology, education simply wouldn't have happened the past many months. As a teacher, I thank God for the brilliant minds who developed it all and found creative ways to help us connect with students. But with all blessings come shadows.

We have depended on devices for remote school and work for more than a year, but now it's summer and time to help our kids step out of the shadow of too much technology. I'd like to offer a few tips and tricks to help you unplug, unwind and reset your kids this summer.

Show instead of tell: As parents, we have to set the example. Even though we may still be working remotely, which requires screen time, we have to show our kids how to cut back and step away ... together.

Get in the zone: Establish clear times and places where devices are strictly off-limits for everyone. The bedroom and the dinner table are the first suggestions. Make sure to include everyone in the conversation. They need to hear that we value technology, but too much is not a good thing.

Make the switch: If you take something away, you need to add something new. Too much screen time decreases creativity and communication, so, as a counterbalance, replace screen time with swimming, biking and exploring the neighborhood. Build creativity with a trip to the library to read real books, or play board games in the back yard. Go on a picnic, and remember, the value is in the event rather than the food, so no need to get fancy. Grab the old digital or disposable camera, come up with some fun categories and have a family photo contest.

Non-digital discipleship: Serve ... someone, anyone, just put down the devices and go do something for another one of God's children. Cook, mow, rake, bake cookies or just stop by for a game of cards and a visit.

Projects: Life isn't always fun and games, so get your family team together and do some projects. Organizing, cleaning, sorting, building, planting or tending build responsibility, teamwork and work ethic.

Use the phrase: Sometimes we forget it's OK to simply say, "Because I said so!" Our job requires us to do things that kids don't like because we know it's good for them; so don't be afraid to use the phrase, and even remove the devices completely for a time so new habits can be established.

Reconnection: To whom do we truly want our kids connected? The answer is family, and Jesus, so putting away the devices so our kids can connect with those who love them most and are the most important is essential.


