Faith Formation classes


Religious Education, also known as RelEd or Faith Formation, gives students the information and the tools that they need to realize and respond to God's love for them.



In 1955, a husband and wife songwriting team attended a youth retreat in California. They put together a song that captured their hopes for a better, more peaceful world. Saint Maria Goretti

1890 - 1902 FEAST DAY — JULY 6

n 6 July 1902, Maria Goretti died in the hospital at Nettuno, brutally stabbed the day before in the village of Le Ferriere, in the Pontine Marshes. Her spiritual life, the strength of her faith, her ability to forgive her murderer have placed her among the best-loved saints of the 20th century. St Maria Goretti was a girl whom God's Spirit endowed with the courage to stay faithful to her Christian vocation even to the point of making the supreme sacrifice of her life. Her tender age, her lack of education and the poverty of the environment in which she lived did not prevent grace from working its miracles in her. Indeed, it was precisely in these conditions that God's special love for the lowly appeared. We are reminded of the words with which Jesus blesses the heavenly Father for revealing himself to children and the simple, rather than to the wise and learned of the world.

Jubilee Year 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

I forgot how to go to confession. How do I do that?

The first thing you need to confess your sins is to be truly sorry for them and to want to sin no more. Take time to think about your sins, you can find guides online to help you think about them. Consider what is the root cause of your sin.

Next, set a day and time for going to confession. Either make an appointment, or to be more anonymous, go when the parish or pilgrimage site has confession times. When you are in the confessional, tell the priest the last time you made a confession. If you cannot remember, tell him that. Tell him your sins and express your sorrow for it. The priest may ask questions or offer advice. Then he will give you a penance – remember it. Last, he will pray the absolution over you and tell you to go in peace. Finish by fulfilling your penance. It is often a prayer(s) but sometimes more. Make sure you take time for this.

There is no reason to be afraid of confession; Jesus awaits you.

Preguntas Frecuentes Sobre el Año Jubilar 2025

Olvidé cómo confesarme. ¿Cómo hago eso?

Lo primero que necesitas para confesar tus pecados es sentir verdadero arrepentimiento por ellos y querer no pecar más. Tómate un tiempo para reflexionar sobre tus pecados, puedes encontrar guías en el Internet que te ayuden a pensarlos. Considera cuál es la raíz de tu pecado.

Luego, elige un día y una hora para confesarte. Puedes hacer una cita, o si prefieres mayor anonimato, acude durante los horarios regulares de confesión en tu parroquia o en el lugar de peregrinación. Cuando estés en el confesionario, comienza diciendo al sacerdote cuándo fue la última vez que te confesaste. Si no lo recuerdas, simplemente díselo. Luego, confiesa tus pecados con sinceridad y expresa tu arrepentimiento. El sacerdote puede hacerte algunas preguntas o darte un consejo. Después, te asignará una penitencia — recuerda cumplirla— y pronunciará la oración de absolución sobre ti, devolviéndote la paz del perdón. Cumple tu penitencia con calma y atención. A veces consiste en rezar ciertas oraciones; otras veces puede implicar una acción concreta. Sea lo que sea, tómate el tiempo necesario.

No tengas miedo de la confesión: Jesús te espera con amor y misericordia.



Archbishop Henning (June 29, 2025):

"Today's Mass for the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul and the blessing and imposition of the Pallium Stole expresses the unity of the Church in the successor of Peter. By the gift of this stole placed within the tomb of Peter, Pope Leo links my ministry in Boston to his own and to the communion of the Catholic Church across the world. He spoke today about the character of that communion, a unity that does not diminish our individual freedom, dignity, or diversity. Communion in the Lord ever makes us more, not less - as individuals and as a community. The imagery of the stole also reminds me to imitate the Good Shepherd in caring for the flock and seeking out the lost sheep. I will return from Rome renewed and determined to live up to that charge in serving the Church of Boston. The Catholics of the Archdiocese of Boston are in my heart and in my prayers."


