

Érase una vez un padre de familia que intentaba leer el periódico después de un largo día de trabajo. A cada instante era importunado por sus hijos. Uno le pedía dinero para ir a comprarse un helado. Otro se le acercaba llorando, se había hecho daño en el pie y quería que un beso lo curara. El mayor le pedía que le ayudara a resolver un problema de matemáticas. Finalmente el más pequeño entró corriendo en la sala en busca del buen padre. Éste le preguntó cansado: "¿y tú que quieres?" El pequeño le contestó: "Papá, yo no quiero nada. Sólo quiero que me cojas en tus brazos".

Marta y María, trabajo y oración, lucha y contemplación, tierra y cielo, el trabajo en la fábrica y el descanso en la iglesia, los hombres y Dios. Nuestra vida es como

una gran tela de araña tejida con muchos hilos y cada hilo es necesario e importante. El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que todo es importante pero cuando estamos con Jesús, Él es el más importante y sólo una cosa es necesaria, escucharle y caer en sus brazos.

Supongamos que Dios, nuestro Padre, nos preguntara hoy: "¿Y tú que quieres?". Me imagino que se sorprendería muchísimo si nuestra respuesta fuera como la del niño pequeño: "No quiero nada. Sólo quiero que me cojas en tus brazos, disfrutar de tu compañía, estar contigo". El domingo es el día en que practicamos esta lección del Señor: "Una sola cosa es necesaria". Cualquiera que escoge esto, escoge la mejor parte. Los que desprecian las cosas del espíritu viven la desunión interior, viven en la dimensión temporal, cerrados a la trascendencia.

A los que les gusta la juerga y los juegos, difícilmente serán criticados; a los que les gustan las cosas de Dios están expuestos a la crítica y, a veces, a la burla. Marta criticó a María e incluso se quejó al Señor que no le decía nada. "Una sola cosa es necesaria", le contestó a Marta. El corazón humano de Jesús tenía hambre de amor y no de la cena de siete platos que Marta le estaba preparando. Si no somos alimentados con el plato del amor nunca seremos felices.

Jesús vino a ofrecernos su amor y la Buena Noticia de la salvación y Marta estaba afanándose en la cocina. Jesús no le dijo a Marta que le hubiera desatendido, dijo simplemente que María le había ofrecido el mejor regalo. Dios nos llama a amarle y a servirle. Nuestro amor se expresa en la oración. La oración es la hospitalidad para con Dios. Le escuchamos y le hablamos. Jesús nos mandó orar siempre; nunca nos dijo que trabajáramos siempre.

"Venid a mi todos los que estáis cansados y agobiados y os daré el descanso". No estamos en la iglesia para cumplir con una pesada obligación sino para descansar en la presencia del Señor. Necesitamos muchas cosas pero sólo unas pocas son necesarias y una sola cosa es absolutamente necesaria conocer, amar y servir a Dios nuestro Padre. Hay un tiempo para trabajar y un tiempo para orar. Hay un tiempo para olvidar y un tiempo para recordar. Hay días laborables y hay domingos. El domingo es el día en que cada cristiano da hospedaje a Dios y escucha a Jesucristo.

July 13 ~ Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"... heed the voice of the LORD, your God, and keep his commandments and statutes ...," Moses reminds us that the commandments are readily accessible. The command, simply put is - Love God, love your neighbor. That commandment is made abundantly clear to us in the parable of the Good Samaritan that Jesus presents in today's gospel. Who is "my neighbor" that needs assistance today? We don't have to look very hard to see who that might be. As we heard in the first reading, we have the ability, it is "already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out." Jesus not only challenges us to be responsive, he also promises to give us the grace we need to carry out his command.

Applications are available for pick up at the Parish Office located at 46 Winthrop Street.



Saints Joachim and Anne

ot mentioned in the Bible, Joachim and Anne are first named as the parents of Mary in the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James, which may date from the second century. In this story, they are old and childless, like the Old Testament Hannah, mother of Samuel, when angels deliver the news that Anne will conceive a child. Anne was an especially popular saint in medieval England, and her feast was celebrated in the West by 1350; Joachim's feast was authorized or suppressed by various popes, but was joined with Anne's in 1969. They are the patrons of married couples; Anne is also the patron of childless women, expectant mothers, and miners.

"Mary grew up in the home of Joachim and Anne; she was surrounded by their love and faith: in their home she learned to listen to the Lord and to follow his will. Saints Joachim and Anne were part of a long chain of people who had transmitted their faith and love for God, expressed in the warmth and love of family life, down to Mary, who received the Son of God in her womb and who gave him to the world, to us. How precious is the family as the privileged place for transmitting the faith!"



16th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Recent polls find that many people think of themselves as less religious, but more spiritual. Religion is judged to be impractical, or not as 'enlightened' as modern people. Those ideas and distinctions have been around for centuries and the only ones who are still going strong are those who practice religion.

Jesus visits Martha and Mary and they each have a different view of what needs to be done and who should do it. Martha is concerned about all the details of hospitality while Mary wants to listen to what Jesus has to say. When Martha objects and wants her sister's help, Jesus reminds her that only one thing is important and since Mary has chosen it, she should not be deprived of it.

The practice of faith often takes second place to many other things that take our time and energy and give very little in return. Our choices leave little time for prayer, works of mercy or religious activity. Yet these are the only things that really count. They express our values and ideals, helping us to be missionaries of faith and witnesses of love. Don't be fooled by the clutter of life and make busyness your excuse. Faith contains the treasure of life, a meaning and purpose that satisfy us. The better portion awaits our choosing.




