August 17 ~ Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Later today, pause for a few minutes to read again today's readings. Who comes to mind when you hear that you are surrounded by "so great a cloud of witnesses"? Is it people from your own life that are/were pillars of faith, or someone who strived to be "Christ-like" and persevered even when faced with hardships? St. Paul urges us to be like those witnesses who persevered in faith and ran the race to eternal life by "...keeping ... eyes fixed on Jesus." The baton has been passed on to us – let's fix our eyes on Jesus as we stay the course with the hope to be counted among that cloud of witnesses.

Jubilee Year 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

Why is Jesus our hope?

Because God never gives up on us. He extends his love and mercy to those who want it, even at the eleventh hour. "At times we have the impression that we cannot find meaning for our lives: we feel useless, inadequate, just like the labourers who wait in the marketplace, waiting for someone to hire them to work." The parable of the laborers in the vineyard (Mt 20) "is a parable that gives hope, because it tells us that this landowner goes out several times to go and look for those who are waiting to give meaning to their lives ... God wants to give his Kingdom, that is, full, eternal and happy life, to everyone. And this is what Jesus does with us: he does not establish rankings, he gives all of himself to those who open their hearts to him" (Pope Leo 6/4/25 Audience).

La batuta nos ha sido entregada: fijemos nuestros ojos en Jesús mientras mantenemos el rumbo con la esperanza de ser contados entre esa nube de testigos.

Año Jubilar 2025: Peregrinos de la esperanza

¿Por qué Jesús es nuestra esperanza? Porque Dios nunca se da por vencido con nosotros. Extiende su amor y misericordia a quienes lo desean, incluso en la hora undécima. "A veces tenemos la impresión de que no podemos encontrar sentido a nuestras vidas: nos sentimos inútiles, inadecuados, como los trabajadores que esperan en el mercado, esperando que alguien los contrate para trabajar". La parábola de los obreros de la viña (Mt 20) "es una parábola que da esperanza, porque nos dice que este terrateniente sale varias veces a buscar a los que esperan para dar sentido a su vida... Dios quiere dar a todos su Reino, es decir, vida plena, eterna y feliz. Y esto es lo que Jesús hace con nosotros: no establece rankings, se entrega por completo a quienes le abren su corazón" (Papa León 6/4/25 Audiencia).



QUEENSHIP OF MARY—August 22

Quote:

 \overline{A} great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. \sim Revelation 12:1



Early Church Fathers used what is referred to as "typology" to clearly establish the continuity between the Old and New Testaments. For example, though King Solomon sinned, he is also a prefigurement, or "type" of Christ because he was a peacemaker, filled with wisdom, and built the Temple. Saint Augustine, in his commentary on Psalm 127, states that our Lord is "the true Solomon" and that "Solomon was the figure of this Peacemaker." The true Peacemaker is Christ, and just as Solomon built the Temple, so our Lord built the true Temple of His Body, the Church.

Following this form of typology, the Book of 1 Kings states, "Then Bathsheba went to King Solomon to speak to him for Adonijah, and the king stood up to meet her and paid her homage. Then he sat down upon his throne, and a throne was provided for the king's mother, who sat at his right. She said, 'There is one small favor I would ask of you. Do not refuse me.' The king said to her, 'Ask it, my mother, for I will not refuse you'" (1 Kings 2:19–20). If King Solomon, an Old Testament type of Christ, honored his Queen Mother's requests and sat her on a throne next to his, then so much more does our Lord, the true King of Kings, do so with His mother. Therefore, today's memorial celebrates the fact that, in Heaven, Jesus' mother is seated on a throne next to His, and like Solomon, Jesus says with certainty to her, "Ask it, my mother, for I will not refuse you."

It is for these reasons, that on October 11, 1954, four years after the proclamation of the Assumption, Pope Pius XII instituted the Memorial of the Queenship of Mary with his encyclical letter, Ad Caeli Reginam (The Queen of Heaven). (excerpt)


